

## Obstetric History Taking – Group D

**Introduction** (should include the husband's information as well)

- Name
- Age
- Residency
- Religion
- Blood Group (for Rh compatibility & others)
- Occupation
- Consanguinity
- DOA (Date Of Admission) to the hospital
- GPA
  - **Gravidity:** all pregnancies regardless of the outcome, including the current one
  - **Parity:** number of deliveries after 24 weeks of gestation; alive or dead
  - **Abortion (miscarriage):** any pregnancy that ended before 24 weeks of gestation
- LMP (Last Menstrual Period)
- EDD (Expected Delivery Date)
  - Add 7 days to LMP and subtract 3 months
  - If LMP is in the first three months of the year then we add 7 days and 9 months
- GA (Gestational Age): duration of amenorrhea
  - The best time for calculating GA is in the first trimester
  - 2 months = 9 weeks
  - 3 months = 13 weeks

### Chief Complaint (CC)

- Any abdominal pain in the third trimester isn't necessarily labor pain
- Duration of labor pain shouldn't exceed 24 hours
- Post-op questions are different from Pre-op questions

### History of Present Illness (HPI)

- Details of CC + what has been done for her in the hospital until the time of history taking

### History of Present Pregnancy

- Record details of each trimester.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Trimester: Planned pregnancy or not? How did she find out that she was pregnant?
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester: Fetal movements? Is nausea better? Blood Pressure? Blood Glucose?
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Trimester: Headache? Leg edema?

### Review of Systems (Regarding the Chief Complaint)

#### Past Histories

- **Obstetric**
  - Pregnancy by pregnancy
- **Gynecological**
  - Menarche
  - Cycle (Regular? Complications?)
  - PID (Pelvic Inflammatory Diseases)
  - Contraception methods
  - History of Infertility
- **Medical** (Hepatitis, Blood transfusions)
- **Surgical** (Anesthesia?)
- **Social**
