

## **FOURTH YEAR CLINICAL COURSE IN OBSTETRICS**

### **First Week:**

History taking and obstetrical examination. The student should be able to take a full detailed obstetric history and perform an obstetrical examination.

During this week the student should become familiar with the obstetrical terminology and their definitions.

### **Second Week:**

Normal labor and its management, antenatal care, hyperemesis gravidarum, partogram and abnormal labor progression, fetal assessment in labor, prolonged pregnancy and its management.

### **Third Week:**

Discussing the most important medical condition that may arise during pregnancy or may complicate it such as: hypertension, diabetes, anemia, urinary problems (cystitis and pyelonephritis) and heart diseases.

### **Fourth Week:**

Obstetrical emergencies and operative obstetrics: episiotomy, genital injury, APH, PPH, eclamptic fit, caesarian section.
